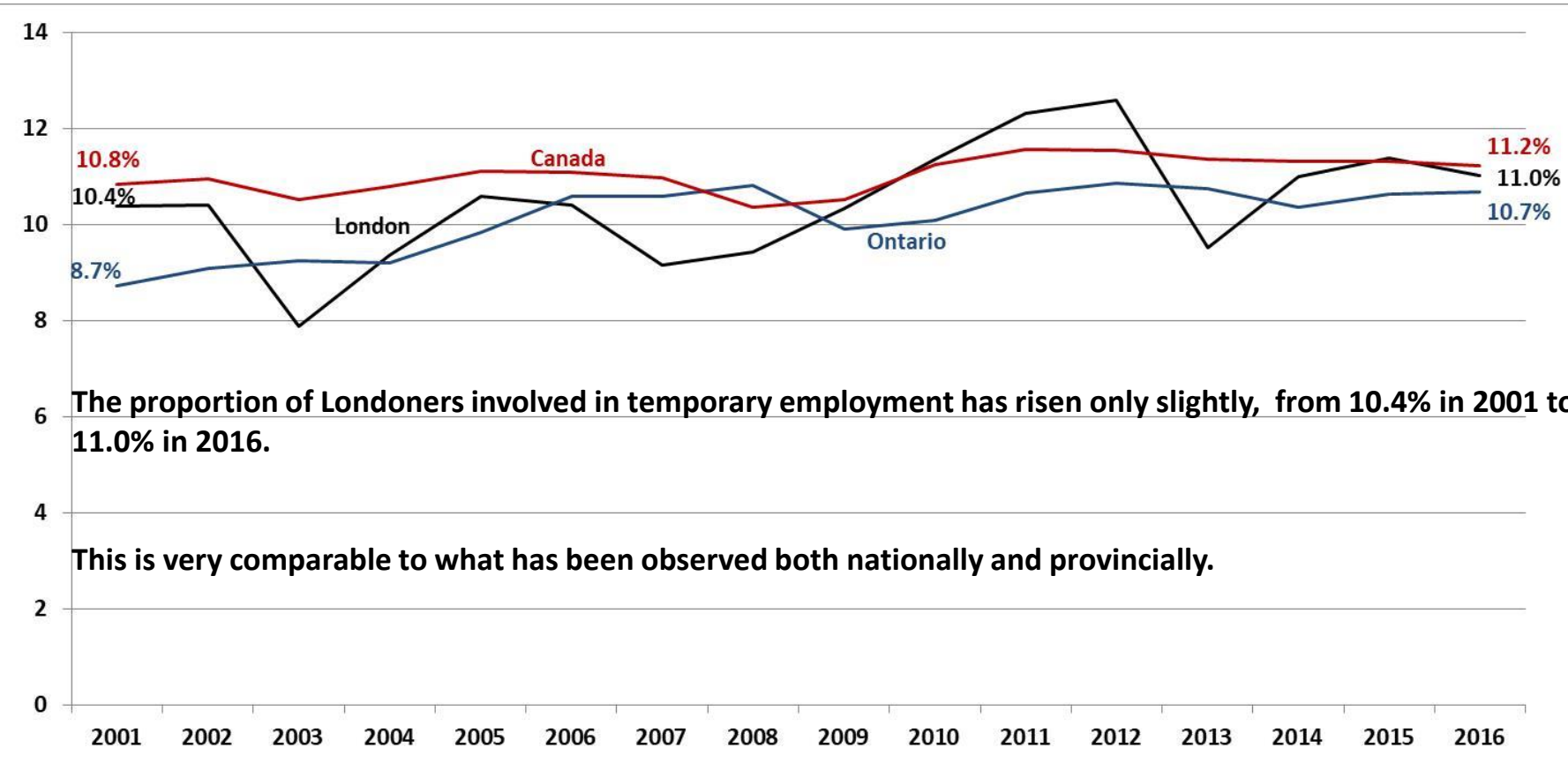


Percentage of employed persons in temporary jobs, London, Ontario and Canada, 2001-2016



The proportion of Londoners involved in temporary employment has risen only slightly, from 10.4% in 2001 to 11.0% in 2016.

This is very comparable to what has been observed both nationally and provincially.
